Subject: Water main extension project

Hi Rosalyn,

Many thanks for all of your efforts on this project, much appreciated.

Here are my notes from this afternoon's meeting. Please let me know if there are any misunderstandings, or things to add:

1. You will email us the property list and cost/year/property.
2. Please could you also email us a digital copy of the petition document?
3. There is a 40 fixture limit/property and you will be emailing us on how to count this.
4. No connection is permitted between the well system and the new water system.
5. If the length of the water main connection within the property, is greater than 90M from the point of connection at the road to the fixture furthest away, the property owner will be responsible for getting an assessment of requirements in order for a proper water supply.
6. Property owners can expect to pay about \$300 for a connection and are limited to one/property.
7. There will not be any fire hydrants, though there may be stand-pipes and there may be Hydrant connections included for future use.
8. Property owners will state where the road connection is to be placed.
9. The District owns 2 properties and you will establish signing authority (and hopefully get us the signatures!).
10. Within the property the line will need to be 18-24" deep.
11. You will be the contact for questions of the District and Karen will be the residents spokesperson.
12. We may begin collecting signatures as long as we let owners know that we do not have the owner's list yet.
13. We will let the District know which property owners we have not contacted.
14. Faxed petition responses are okay.
