Hi, Frank. I've discussed this with Gary, and we will have the bylaws 'in our back pocket' regardless of the solicitor's advice, just incase Council elects to take a risk and move ahead. That way, we would have intro & first 3 readings on the 16<sup>th</sup> and final approval on the 23<sup>rd</sup>. After that Bob Thompson is away for 5 weeks, and then things will be headed to "election slowdown" by the time he returns.

As far as the Brentwood bay group, we are aware of their opposition, (mostly in the form of Lori Waters and Zeb King, who have aligned themselves with that group) and so is Council. We'll just have to deal with it, but if the legal advice comes back positive, it will be much easier for all of us. I think Council's feeling, as ours, is that one way or another we have to have a decision this week, so I'm keeping my fingers crossed with respect to the legal opinion. And once the bylaw is approved, things will get going, and the best response to the opposition is "Council has approved the bylaw and the project is going ahead." So I'm hoping for that.

As I mentioned, Lori Waters has consumed a great deal of staff time, as well as a lot of space on the agenda, and patience is wearing thin with her on all sides. But we have a duty to respond...
