At the Council meeting on Feb. 2, I asked the question concerning consultation with First Nations re Senanus water pipeline. I understood that it was a requirement of the grant application. You did not answer that question: Mayor Mar said he had "mentioned it to the Chief and he didn't seem concerned". This is not consultation. This discussion occurred many months after the grant application. The letter from the Province concerning the EIA stated that consultation with First Nations should occur early on in the process.

Why were the representatives from the Tsartlip First Nation ignored during this Council meeting when they had written a letter and were present at the meeting?
