Dear Mayor and Council:

I am writing to ask council not to proceed with three readings of "Mount Newton Cross Road/Senanus Drive Local Area Service Establishment Bylaw No. 1625, 2009". This issue has appeared before council many times in years past, and has never been approved, for a variety of excellent reasons. For a new council to bring this Bylaw to three readings one month after taking office suggests that it was a significant election issue, and that councilors have a mandate to act quickly. I do not recall it being debated at any of the public meetings, and do not feel the speed is warranted.

Further, the application for a grant under the Canada - British Columbia Municipal Rural Infrastructure Fund program has serious problems, which should be resolved before the Bylaw is read.

I urge you to delay action on this Bylaw until the grant difficulties have been settled, and the issue has been debated by the community at large, with consideration of all the facts.
