Mayor and Council,

It is with disappointment that I heard you plan three readings in one council meeting on this subject. When Council railroads a motion through it is always because if normal procedures are followed they know the motion would be defeated.

I declined to add my signature to the original petition. My personal experience is that the petition content was misrepresented and incomplete and the pressure imposed at the doorstep designed to thwart detailed examination of the petition. Much research has gone into this problem after the fact. It all points to this being an unnecessary project.

Ask yourselves, "If Central Saanich had to pay for this project would it be deemed essential?" Fifteen years of previous wise Council decided it was not.

Please take this project to mediation so all voices, Mt. Newton Cross Road residents and Tsartlip Band can input their financial, environmental, cultural and archaeological views. This is referred to as The Senanus Water Main. The negative impact of satisfying the demands of a few has far reaching 'community' repercussions, far beyond those few households on Senanus.
